

## FIRE PLUGS

A busy month for your fire department with training and a fire call. Unfortunately, the fire call had a fatality and our condolences go out to the family.

We had our ice rescue training re-certification, which we do every 3 years. We hosted several other agencies some who are just starting an ice rescue program. There was so much interest that we had 2 classes one on Saturday and one on Sunday with 30 participants each day. After a morning of classroom instruction and a large lunch the people squeezed themselves into their gear and went onto the ice for practical training in front of the Sanderson's who let us take over their waterfront or ice front for the weekend. Ice rescue for us is what the fire service calls a low frequency/high risk event which requires frequent training. Remember to be careful when enjoying recreational activities on ice. Even a pond can be dangerous.

We also had a group travel out to Dafter Township to practice hose lays and fire suppression techniques with departments on the mainland. More training with other departments is planned for the future.

Finally with the winds we have been having lately, you may be putting up a new flag. There is a box on the front of the North End fire station for damaged flags. These are taken to the American Legion Post in the Sault for proper retirement.

# Sugar Island Township News

As the snow melts, and the ground thaws, we know puddles will freeze periodically, and slippery patches will ultimately become a recurring circumstance on our roads, driveways, porches and sidewalks. Please be careful, as you traverse these wet areas.

Also, please be careful when you begin filling your bird feeders. With lots of remaining snow, and warmer weather, our large, furry friends will wake up from their hibernation and will begin looking for an easy opportunity to feast. Bird feeders are an easy target, so please wait until later in May before you begin filling the feeders.


As you may know, the Township's fiscal year ends on March 31<sup>th</sup> which means we will be working on our budget this month. The Annual Township State of the Township presentation along with the 2023-2024 Annual Budget Special Meeting will be scheduled for Thursday, March 23, 2023, at 6:00 pm.

The Township is working with the Chippewa County Road Commission (CCRC) to finish the work on Village Road in 2023 and to begin the planning process for what comes next. The scope of work for what comes next could be paving or it could be lifting, widening, and ditch work. Some of this work may be predicated on the renewal of the millage existing. Also, the Township is working with the CCRC to add new striping to most of the paved roads on the Island this summer.

Additionally, a local Internet Service Provider (ISP) has volunteered to submit a grant to provide broadband to Sugar Island. The Eastern U.P. Connection Consortium (EUPCC) is working with this ISP to provide the data necessary to make sure the grant application has the requisite information. As the Chair of the EUPCC, I will continue to seek providers willing to invest in the process of bringing broadband to Sugar Island. This grant is due to the State of Michigan by March 14, 2023. It is not clear when an announcement will be made but it could happen this summer. To be clear, unless somebody wins the lottery and donates a pile of cash, the Township does not have any designated matching funds for this possibility, thereby making the eventuality largely dependent on grant funds.

Just to be clear, when a broadband, fiber optic provider comes to Sugar Island, we should expect internet quality and speed to improve. However, nobody should expect broadband to be free, or at reduced cost. We should, however, expect the new internet service to be of better quality and speed than most currently available satellite services, except for SPACEX.
