



NOTES: This schedule does not apply to metal recycling.

1. Contractor debris should not be placed in the compactor or Open Top Containers. Contractors should use landfill's located on the mainland.
2. Township pays a standard fee for 24 Open Top Containers (Not Based on Weight).
3. Township pays fees GFL for the Compactors based on weight. Compactors are replaced every other Wednesday.
4. Township pays transportation costs (staff, fuel, etc.) associated with recycling, but nothing for the recycled materials.
5. Northern Transitions pays EUPTA ferry fare.
6. Recycling trailer is taken to the mainland and emptied every other Wednesday.
7. Current staffing levels at the Transfer Stations are not sufficient to manage a fee for service program.
8. Multi-Day events (E.G., Music Fest, Pow Wow, etc.) should either pay for their own disposal (GFL) or use the Transfer Station south of 8 Mile Road on Homestead Road.
9. The 2024-2025 Budget reflects a cut of \$9,400 from this program or 16 Canisters from 2023-2024 schedule.
