- Township pays a standard fee for 24 Open Top Containers (Not Based on Weight).
- Township pays fees GFL for the Compactors based on weight. Compactors are replaced every other Wednesday.
- Township pays transportation costs (staff, fuel, etc.) associated with recycling, but nothing for the recycled materials.
- 5. Northern Transitions pays EUPTA ferry fare.
- Recycling trailer is taken to the mainland and emptied every other Wednesday.
- Current staffing levels at the Transfer Stations are not sufficient to manage a fee for service program.
- Multi-Day events (E.G., Music Fest, Pow Wow, etc.) should either pay for their own disposal (GFL) or use the Transfer Station south of 8 Mile Road on Homestead Road.
